Background:

Instead, it is a program that seeks future business leaders and those early in their careers who are interested in thinking carefully about professional ethics and how they will act in their professional positions when challenged by ethical dilemmas in the future.

Please submit short answers (250-400 words each) to the following four questions by the FASPE application deadline. All four answers should be submitted as ONE single PDF document. Please make sure that you include the question with each answer and that your name appears on the top of every page.

1. Why are you interested in FASPE and how do you think the program will influence your growth as a business leader?
2. What ethical dilemmas, experiences, and/or academic work in your own background will enable you to enrich program discussions?
3. What are your career aspirations and what motivates your career interests? (Please be sure to include information about what type of business career you are interested in pursuing, or are pursuing, and why.)
4. What does professionalism mean to you in the context of your work in business?
