2017 FASPE Medical Application Short Answer Questions

Background:

FASPE Medical explores the history of the Holocaust as a way to engage participants in discussions about contemporary topics. FASPE is not a Holocaust studies program, nor is it a genocide prevention program. Instead, it is a program that seeks medical students who are interested in thinking carefully about medical ethics and how they will act in their work in the future when faced with ethically challenging situations.

Instructions and Questions:

Please submit short answers (250-400 words each) to the following four questions by the FASPE application deadline. All four answers should be submitted as ONE single PDF document. Please make sure that you include the question with each answer and that your name appears on the top of every page.

1. Why are you interested in FASPE and how do you think the program will influence your growth as a physician?
2. What ethical dilemmas, experiences, and academic work in your own background will enable you to enrich program discussions?
3. What are your career aspirations and what motivates your career interests? (What field of medicine are you interested in? Are you interested in clinical, research, policy, or academic work, or some combination of these?)
4. As a future physician, what does professionalism mean to you?
